Concert Dates

Victoria: We've saved £1000 and can buy an xylophone.

Eric: I'll look into it.

James: We need to look into percussion transportation for jobs.

Raymond: We need a second-hand van.

Eric: No. We need to tax it, insure it etc.

Eric: We need a van if we're using all the expensive percussion. I know a guy on Constitution Street.
